



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1) **FUSE** means the event taking place at Spier Wine Farm on Monday 13 May 2019 and is also the opening unconference of We Are Africa travel trade show.

1.2) Organisers means Event Labs (Pty) Ltd, a company registered in South Africa with number 2015/237557/07, being the company operating FUSE in South Africa under license from We Are Africa Shows Ltd.

1.3) Delegate means any person whose application to participate in FUSE has been accepted by the organisers and whose participation fee has been paid in full.

2. FUSE BADGE INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

2.1) The FUSE badge is valid for Monday, 13 May 2019 exclusively and grants a single entry to the full FUSE programme, including lunch and networking drinks at the end of the day.

2.2) In keeping with the unconference format of the event and limited spacing in all sessions, the delegate should be aware that inclusion in the various sessions is on a first come, first served basis.

2.3) Delegates can apply to host discussions, spark talks, workshops and other elements, but selection is entirely at the discretion of the organizers.

2.4) FUSE delegates will not be granted access to the We Are Africa event unless they are pre-registered to attend that event as well.

3. REGISTRATION

3.1) FUSE is only open to pre-registered delegates and badge collection takes place at Spier Wine Farm on the morning of Monday, 13 May 2019 from 08:00 am.

3.1) A FUSE badge and wristband will be handed over on presentation of a registered delegate's photo identification (such as driver's license, ID book or passport). Please Note: email proof or proof of payments will not suffice.

3.3) Registration agents have the right to refuse entry should photo identification not be provided.

3.4) In the case where photo identification is not provided and/or verified, the organisers will not be under no obligation to either supply a badge or refund the registration fee.

3.5) If full payment has not been received prior to registration, the organisers will not be under no obligation to either supply a badge or refund the registration fee.

4. INSURANCE

4.1) Registered delegates are responsible for taking appropriate insurance cover in connection with their attendance at FUSE.

4.2) The organisers, hosts or any individuals associated with the un-conference in any capacity shall not be liable for any kind of loss or damage to personal property of delegates or to delegates themselves.

5. PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

5.1) All payment of Fees must be by bank transfer to the nominated account of Event Labs within 10 days of booking and receipt of an invoice.

5.2) In the event of a delegate cancelling their attendance, no refund will be made by the organisers for either the FUSE badge or the FUSE Extender Package.

5.3) If a delegate fails to make payment via EFT within 10 days of booking and receipt of an invoice, the organisers reserve the right to cancel their booking.

5.4) In the event of a cancellation, delegates are able to request that their badge is transferred to another person not yet registered for FUSE 2019. The organisers will review the request and advise on whether the transfer is successful or not.

6. TAX

6.1) South African delegates are liable to VAT charged at the prevailing rate.

6.2) Delegates are fully responsible for all other tax liabilities as required by local governing authorities. The organisers have no responsibility for the relevant tax process.

7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

7.1) All information conveyed orally, in presentations or otherwise at FUSE is from diverse sources and it is the responsibility of the delegate to validate its accuracy.

7.2) The organisers and hosts accept no responsibility for the validity of the information and the organisers and hosts or any individuals affiliated with the un-conference in any capacity shall have no liability of any kind in any country or court of law in this regard.

7.3) The organisers do not accept liability for death, injury, any loss, cost of expense suffered or incurred by any person if such loss is caused or result from the act, default or omission of any person.

7.4) Furthermore, the organisers and hosts of FUSE do not accept any liability for losses arising from the provision or non-provision of services provided by local companies or transport operators.

7.5) The organisers and hosts do not accept liability for losses suffered by reason of war, including threat of war, riots and civil strife, terrorist activity, natural disaster, weather, fire, flood, drought, technical, mechanical or electrical breakdown within any premises visited by delegates and/or partners in connection with the un-conference, industrial dispute, governmental action, regulations or technical problems which may affect the services provided in connection with FUSE.
